AN ACT CONCERNING THE USE OF BODY SCANNING MACHINES IN THE PUBLIC ENTRANCE AREAS OF CORRECTIONAL FACILITIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the Commissioner of Correction be required to report to the joint
- 2 standing committees of the General Assembly having cognizance of
- 3 matters relating to the Department of Correction and appropriations
- 4 and the budgets of state agencies on the use of body scanning machines
- 5 in the public entrance areas of correctional facilities.

Statement of Purpose:

To require the Commissioner of Correction to report to the General Assembly on the use of body scanning machines in the public entrance areas of correctional facilities.
