AN ACT CONCERNING POLICE OFFICER MISCONDUCT, MEETINGS BETWEEN LAW ENFORCEMENT AND STAKEHOLDERS AND FUNDING FOR COMMUNITY POLICING PROGRAMS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to (1) establish a system for
- 2 monitoring and addressing police misconduct, (2) require law
- 3 enforcement to be more responsive and accountable to their
- 4 communities with regularly scheduled roundtable meetings with
- 5 various stakeholders, and (3) increase funding for community policing
- 6 programs that aim to build trust between law enforcement and the
- 7 communities they serve.

Statement of Purpose:

To increase public safety by building trust between law enforcement officers and the communities they serve and holding law enforcement officers accountable for their actions.
