AN ACT EXPANDING ACCESS TO THE STATE-FUNDED PORTION OF THE CONNECTICUT HOME-CARE PROGRAM FOR THE ELDERLY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 17b-342 of the general statutes be amended to reduce
- 2 copayments and increase asset limits to forty-five thousand dollars for
- 3 an individual and sixty-five thousand dollars for a married couple for
- 4 participants of the state-funded portion of the Connecticut home-care
- 5 program for the elderly.

Statement of Purpose:

To expand access to the state-funded portion of the Connecticut home-care program for the elderly by reducing copayments and increasing asset limits.
