**AN ACT ENCOURAGING LOCAL SCHOOL DISTRICTS TO
REGIONALIZE.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 10-285a of the general statutes be amended to reduce the
- 2 percentage a town may receive for a school building project grant by
- 3 twenty points if such town (1) has fewer than twenty-five thousand
- 4 residents, (2) is not a member of a regional school district, and (3)
- 5 contains a high school that is under the jurisdiction of the local board of
- 6 education for the town.

Statement of Purpose:

To encourage school districts to regionalize by reducing the reimbursement percentage for a school building project grant for certain towns.
