AN ACT CONCERNING QUALIFYING CONTRIBUTIONS UNDER THE CITIZENS' ELECTION PROGRAM.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That chapter 157 of the general statutes be amended to require that 2 the State Elections Enforcement Commission, when reviewing the 3 application of a candidate for a grant from the Citizens' Election Fund, 4 provide to such candidate (1) a list of each contribution to the 5 candidate committee of such candidate that said commission has not deemed a qualifying contribution, and (2) an explanation for each such 6 7 contribution of why said commission has not deemed it a qualifying 8 contribution.

Statement of Purpose:

To require the State Elections Enforcement Commission to advise candidates applying for grants under the Citizens' Election Program of why certain contributions are not deemed qualifying contributions.
