**AN ACT CONCERNING THE USE OF SODIUM CHLORIDE TO
MITIGATE SNOW AND ICE ACCUMULATIONS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to add liability protections
- 2 related to sodium chloride damage for municipalities that follow and
- 3 received certification in the Department of Energy and Environmental
- 4 Protection's recommended sodium chloride mitigation program,
- 5 known as the Connecticut Best Management Practices "Green Snow Pro:
- 6 Sustainable Winter Operations" guide for municipalities.

Statement of Purpose:

To provide training, certification and protection from liability for roadside applicators of sodium chloride who use best practices when applying sodium chloride which, in turn, will reduce the environmental impact of such applications.
