**AN ACT CONCERNING HEATING EFFICIENCY IN NEW
CONSTRUCTION AND MAJOR ALTERATIONS OF RESIDENTIAL
BUILDINGS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to: (1) Prohibit the use of
- 2 electric resistance or fossil fuel combustion systems in new residential
- 3 construction or major alterations of residential buildings; and (2)
- 4 establish a program for training and education of construction
- 5 professionals in certain alternative residential heating sources.

Statement of Purpose:

To require new construction of residential homes to use HVAC sources that do not use fossil fuels or electric resistance.
