AN ACT PROHIBITING TELECOMMUNICATIONS COMPANIES FROM CHARGING CUSTOMERS TO RECEIVE PAPER BILLS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That title 16 of the general statutes be amended to prohibit 2 telecommunications companies, including telephone, Internet, 3 community antenna television and video service providers, from 4 charging customers a fee to receive a bill in paper form.

Statement of Purpose:

To prohibit Internet, telephone and cable providers from charging customers to receive paper copies of their bills.
