**AN ACT PROHIBITING TELECOMMUNICATIONS COMPANIES FROM CHARGING CUSTOMERS TO RECEIVE PAPER BILLS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That title 16 of the general statutes be amended to prohibit
- 2 telecommunications companies, including telephone, Internet,
- 3 community antenna television and video service providers, from
- 4 charging customers a fee to receive a bill in paper form.

**Statement of Purpose:**

To prohibit Internet, telephone and cable providers from charging customers to receive paper copies of their bills.
