## AN ACT REQUIRING PROPERTY AND CASUALTY INSURERS TO SEND NOTICE TO HOMEOWNERS CONCERNING HOMEOWNERS INSURANCE PREMIUMS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

That title 38a of the general statutes be amended to require each property and casualty insurer that delivers, issues for delivery, renews, amends or endorses a homeowners policy for a residential dwelling in this state notify each owner of such residential dwelling when (1) such insurer receives payment from a mortgage company for any portion of the premiums for such policy, or (2) the premiums for such policy have increased.

## Statement of Purpose:

To require that certain property and casualty insurers notify homeowners when such insurers receive premium payments for homeowners policies from mortgage companies or increase the premiums for such policies.
