AN ACT ESTABLISHING A REFUNDABLE VETERANS' CAREGIVER TAX CREDIT AGAINST THE PERSONAL INCOME TAX.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That chapter 229 of the general statutes be amended to establish a
- 2 refundable veterans' caregiver tax credit against the personal income tax
- 3 for taxpayers who: (1) Pay or incur expenses for the care and support of
- 4 a family member who (A) is receiving veterans' disability payments for
- 5 a service-connected total disability, and (B) resides in the state with the
- 6 taxpayer for not less than six months of the taxable year; and (2) have a
- 7 federal adjusted gross income of two hundred thousand dollars or less
- 8 for single filers and four hundred thousand dollars or less for married
- 9 individuals filing jointly. The amount of the credit shall be the amount
- 10 of the disability payments received in a taxable year by the family
- 11 member or six hundred seventy-five dollars, whichever is less.

Statement of Purpose:

To establish a refundable veterans' caregiver tax credit.
