AN ACT INCREASING THE PREVAILING WAGE THRESHOLD.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That subsection (h) of section 31-53 of the general statutes be
- 2 amended to (1) increase the prevailing wage threshold for remodeling,
- 3 refinishing, refurbishing, rehabilitation, alteration or repair from one
- 4 hundred thousand dollars to four hundred thousand dollars, and (2)
- 5 require the prevailing wage threshold for new construction to be
- 6 indexed annually to reflect the rate of inflation.

Statement of Purpose:

To increase the prevailing wage thresholds.
