AN ACT CONCERNING THE REVIEW OF A PERSON FOR DISCHARGE FROM COMMITMENT BY THE PSYCHIATRIC SECURITY REVIEW BOARD.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That part V of chapter 319i of the general statutes be amended to
- 2 require the Psychiatric Security Review Board to consider factors other
- 3 than risk when making a determination as to whether to discharge an
- 4 acquittee from commitment to the jurisdiction of the board.

Statement of Purpose:

To allow for the Psychiatric Security Review Board's comprehensive consideration of multiple factors in its decision-making process.
