AN ACT CONCERNING CRIMINAL HISTORY RECORDS CHECKS OF HOME HEALTH CARE AGENCY AND HOMEMAKER-COMPANION AGENCY EMPLOYEES AND SUBCONTRACTORS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to require a criminal history
- 2 records check of all current and future employees and subcontractors
- 3 of home health care agencies and homemaker-companion agencies.

Statement of Purpose:

To expand criminal history records checks of home health care agencies and homemaker-companion agencies.
