AN ACT CONCERNING PATIENT CHOICE AND CONTINUITY OF CARE DURING HEALTH INSURANCE CONTRACT DISPUTES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That chapter 700c of the general statutes be amended to allow any
- 2 covered person under a health insurance policy that is the subject of a
- 3 health care contract dispute between such covered person's health care
- 4 provider and the health insurer, resulting in such health care provider
- 5 being deemed out-of-network, to terminate such policy and enroll in a
- 6 new health insurance policy that provides in-network coverage, without
- 7 any early termination fees, financial penalties, increased premiums,
- 8 increased out-of-pocket expenses, changes in coverage or coverage
- 9 gaps.

Statement of Purpose:

To allow any covered person under a health insurance policy that is the subject of a health care contract dispute between such covered person's health care provider and the health insurer, resulting in such health care provider being deemed out-of-network, to terminate such policy and enroll in a new health insurance policy that provides in-network

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coverage, without any early termination fees, financial penalties, increased premiums, increased out-of-pocket expenses, changes in coverage or coverage gaps.

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
