**AN ACT CONCERNING THE EXTENSION OF SPECIAL EDUCATION SERVICES TO CERTAIN CHILDREN.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That subdivision (1) of subsection (b) of section 10-76d of the
- 2 general statutes be amended to require that the obligation for each
- 3 local and regional board of education to provide special education to a
- 4 child shall terminate when such child reaches age twenty-one or is
- 5 graduated from high school, whichever occurs later.

**Statement of Purpose:**

To extend special education services to children and young adults who need service for social, executive functioning and life skills.
