AN ACT REDUCING THE POPULATION THRESHOLD FOR MUNICIPALITIES TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR RECEIVERS TO POSSESS AND REHABILITATE BUILDINGS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

That subdivision (1) of subsection (b) of section 8-169aa of the general statutes be amended to reduce, from thirty-five thousand or more to twenty-five thousand or more, the population threshold for a municipality to be eligible for a receiver to take possession and undertake rehabilitation of a building within such municipality.
