AN ACT CONCERNING THE GRANTING OF ZONING VARIANCES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That title 8 of the general statutes be amended to provide that a
- 2 zoning variance may be granted by a zoning board of appeals if the
- 3 literal enforcement of a zoning regulation would create an exceptional
- 4 difficulty or unusual hardship because of a unique characteristic of the
- 5 subject property.

Statement of Purpose:

To provide that a zoning variance may be granted by a zoning board of appeals if the literal enforcement of a zoning regulation would create an exceptional difficulty or unusual hardship because of a unique characteristic of the subject property.
