**AN ACT CONCERNING MEMBERS OF THE ARMED FORCES AND
CERTAIN DEPARTMENT OF MOTOR VEHICLES FINES OR LATE
FEES.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 27-102a of the general statutes be amended to provide
- 2 that, if a member of the armed forces is due for a motor vehicle
- 3 operator's license renewal or has a vehicle that is due for a registration
- 4 renewal or emissions testing, but such member is serving outside of the
- 5 state and is unable to complete such renewal or testing in a timely
- 6 manner, such member shall be exempt from the payment of any fine or
- 7 late fee associated with such renewal or testing if such member
- 8 completes such renewal or testing not later than ninety days after
- 9 returning to the state.

Statement of Purpose:

To afford members of the armed forces serving outside of the state a
grace period upon their return to the state for the completion of certain
motor vehicle-related renewals or testing, during which period fines
and late fees therefor are waived.
