AN ACT CONCERNING REVIEW OF ELECTION LAWS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (NEW) (Effective October 1, 2019) (a) There is established 2 an Election Law Review Commission for the purpose of reviewing the 3 state's election laws, including, but not limited to, laws regarding (1) 4 the timing of primaries to be held for the nomination of candidates for 5 election, (2) the election of certain constitutional officers, and (3) the 6 regulation of political campaigns. The commission shall consist of the 7 president pro tempore of the Senate, the speaker of the House of 8 Representatives, the minority leader of the Senate, the minority leader 9 of the House of Representatives and the Secretary of the State or the 10 Secretary's designee. The terms of all members of the commission shall 11 end with the termination of each member's term or holding of such 12 office or leadership position, as applicable, whichever occurs first. The 13 president pro tempore of the Senate and the speaker of the House of 14 Representatives shall be cochairpersons of the commission. A majority 15 of the membership shall constitute a quorum and all actions of the

commission shall require the affirmative vote of a majority of the full

- committee membership. The Election Law Review Commission shall meet as often as may be necessary to perform its duties.
- 19 (b) On or before February 15, 2020, and annually thereafter, the
 20 Election Law Review Commission shall submit a report to the joint
 21 standing committee of the General Assembly having cognizance of
 22 matters relating to elections, in accordance with section 11-4a of the
 23 general statutes, and make any recommendation for legislation to
 24 address any issue discussed in such report.
