AN ACT CONCERNING ACCESS TO A COMPREHENSIVE SCHOOL COUNSELING PROGRAM.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That title 10 of the general statutes be amended to require the State 2 Board of Education, in consultation with the Connecticut School 3 Counselor Association, to adopt guidelines and recommendations that 4 ensure that all students have access to a comprehensive school 5 counseling program that includes manufacturing, trade, academic, 6 social-emotional and post-secondary and career readiness 7 programming delivered by a certified school counselor who has 8 received adequate training.

Statement of Purpose:

To provide students with access to a comprehensive school counseling program.
