**AN ACT CONCERNING THE TOLLING OF TEMPORARY  
RESTRAINING ORDERS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to require that any period of
- 2 incarceration for the respondent of a temporary restraining order be
- 3 excluded from any calculation determining the period of time for
- 4 which the order is in effect and that such order shall be continued
- 5 upon the release from custody of the respondent.

**Statement of Purpose:**

To provide that the time for which a temporary restraining order is in effect does not toll during any period for which the respondent is held in custody.
