AN ACT CONCERNING LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS' RESPONSES TO ICE DETAINERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 54-192h of the general statutes be amended to prohibit
- 2 law enforcement officers from detaining an individual based solely on
- 3 a civil immigration detainer and from sending confidential
- 4 information to United States Immigration and Customs Enforcement
- 5 unless mandated by federal law, to clarify probation officers are law
- 6 enforcement officers for purposes of this section and to make public
- 7 and accessible information about state and local agencies
- 8 communications with United States Immigration and Customs
- 9 Enforcement.

Statement of Purpose:

To prohibit certain actions by law enforcement officers in response to a civil immigration detainer, to clarify that probation officers are law enforcement officers and to provide for greater transparency concerning the communications between state and local agencies and the United States Immigration and Customs Enforcement.
