AN ACT CONCERNING PROPERTY TAX EXEMPTIONS FOR MOTOR VEHICLES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

That the general statutes be amended to allow a municipality, upon the affirmative vote of the municipality's legislative body, to (1) exempt any motor vehicle from property taxation, and (2) increase the tax assessment rate on real property, for a period of not more than five years, to offset any revenue lost as a result of exempting motor vehicles from property taxation.

Statement of Purpose:

To allow a municipality to exempt motor vehicles and increase real property taxes, for a period of not more than five years, to offset any lost revenue.
