AN ACT RESTORING SERVICE ON THE SHORE LINE EAST RAIL LINE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the Department of Transportation restore service on the Shore
- 2 Line East rail line to the same level of service that existed prior to the
- 3 reduction in service due to the COVID-19 public health emergency and
- 4 the civil preparedness emergency declared by the Governor on March
- 5 10, 2020.
