AN ACT CONCERNING OCCUPATIONAL LICENSE INTERSTATE RECIPROCITY FOR CERTAIN MILITARY-RELATED INDIVIDUALS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to provide that, if any veteran,
- 2 member of the armed forces or immediate family of a member of the
- 3 armed forces is the holder of an occupational license in another state,
- 4 the corresponding licensing authority for such occupation in this state
- 5 shall, upon application thereto by such individual, consider such other
- 6 state's occupational license to be valid at a similar scope of practice and
- 7 in the discipline applied for in this state.

Statement of Purpose:

To provide for occupational license interstate reciprocity for certain military-related individuals.
