**AN ACT REQUIRING A STUDY OF THE ACCESSIBILITY OF THE
LEGISLATIVE OFFICE BUILDING AND STATE CAPITOL BUILDING.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Assembly convened:

- 1 That the Joint Committee on Legislative Management be required to
- 2 contract with a third-party entity to (1) study the Legislative Office
- 3 Building and State Capitol building to assess their current accessibility
- 4 for persons with disabilities, and (2) make recommendations on
- 5 improving accessibility and bringing such buildings in compliance with
- 6 the most recent Americans with Disability Act standards.

Statement of Purpose:

To study the accessibility of the Legislative Office Building and State
Capitol building.
