**AN ACT CONCERNING OCCUPATIONAL SAFETY AND HEALTH  
ADMINISTRATION TEN-HOUR TRAINING CARDS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General  
Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to make Occupational Safety
- 2 and Health Administration ten-hour training cards valid for ten years
- 3 before requiring renewal for contractors that have employees doing
- 4 work on a public building project that is being paid for in part or in
- 5 full by state funding or a state agency, where the total cost for such
- 6 project is over one hundred thousand dollars.

**Statement of Purpose:**

To reduce costs to state contractors by extending Occupational Safety  
and Health Administration ten-hour training card validity from five  
years to ten years.
