AN ACT CONCERNING UNITED STATES FLAG EMBLEMS ON CERTAIN INDIVIDUALS' MOTOR VEHICLE OPERATOR'S LICENSES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to allow an emblem of the
- 2 United States flag to appear on the Connecticut motor vehicle
- 3 operator's license of an individual who (1) served in the armed forces,
- 4 and (2) is not a veteran, as defined in section 27-103 of the general
- 5 statutes.

Statement of Purpose:

To allow a United States flag emblem to appear on certain individuals' motor vehicle operator's licenses.
