AN ACT CONCERNING ELECTED AND APPOINTED CONSTABLES AS LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICIALS DURING A STATE OR NATIONAL EMERGENCY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

That the general statutes be amended to designate elected and appointed constables as law enforcement officials eligible for services and products through the First Responder Network Authority during a state or national emergency, provided such designation shall not expand the duties and responsibilities of such constables.

Statement of Purpose:

To allow constables to be classified as law enforcement during state and national emergencies for certain purposes.
