**AN ACT AUTHORIZING BONDS OF THE STATE FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF A WOMEN'S HALFWAY HOUSE IN NEW HAVEN.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the State Bond Commission be empowered to authorize the
- 2 issuance of bonds of the state in accordance with section 3-20 of the
- 3 general statutes, in principal amounts not exceeding in the aggregate
- 4 five hundred thousand dollars, the proceeds of which shall be used by
- 5 the Department of Economic and Community Development for the
- 6 purpose of providing a grant-in-aid to the city of New Haven for the
- 7 development of a women's halfway house in New Haven for women
- 8 transitioning back into the community from incarceration.
