AN ACT CONCERNING THE ESTABLISHMENT OF AND BONDING FOR A PROGRAM TO ADDRESS FOOD INSECURITY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That (1) title 17b of the general statutes be amended to establish
- 2 within the Department of Social Services a program to be known as "No
- 3 One Should Go Hungry" to address the needs of persons who are food
- 4 insecure, and (2) the State Bond Commission be empowered to
- 5 authorize the issuance of bonds of the state in accordance with section
- 6 3-20 of the general statutes, in principal amounts not exceeding in the
- 7 aggregate three million dollars, the proceeds of which shall be used by
- 8 the Department of Social Services for the purpose of implementing such
- 9 program.

Statement of Purpose:

To establish and fund a program within the Department of Social Services to address food insecurity.
