AN ACT EXEMPTING CERTAIN COOKWARE FROM PFAS REQUIREMENTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. Subdivision (10) of subsection (a) of section 22a-903c of the
2 general statutes is repealed and the following is substituted in lieu
3 thereof (*Effective from passage*):

4 (10) "Cookware" means durable houseware items used to prepare,
5 dispense or store food, foodstuffs or beverages, including, but not
6 limited to, pots, pans, skillets, grills, baking sheets, baking molds, trays,
7 plates, bowls, cutlery and cooking utensils. "Cookware" does not
8 include any polymer-coated durable items that the United States Food
9 and Drug Administration authorizes for food contact.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:

Section 1	<i>from passage</i>	22a-903c(a)(10)
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Statement of Purpose:

To exempt certain cookware from the statutory PFAS requirements applicable to consumer goods.
