AN ACT AUTHORIZING BONDS OF THE STATE FOR THE COMPLETION OF A PEDESTRIAN BRIDGE AND UNDERPASS IN THE TOWN OF COLUMBIA.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the State Bond Commission be empowered to authorize the
- 2 issuance of bonds of the state in accordance with section 3-20 of the
- 3 general statutes, in principal amounts not exceeding in the aggregate
- 4 two million dollars, the proceeds of which shall be used by the
- 5 Department of Energy and Environmental Protection for the purpose of
- 6 providing a grant-in-aid to the town of Columbia for the completion of
- 7 the pedestrian bridge over the Hop River and the Flanders Road
- 8 underpass.
