AN ACT CONCERNING THE STATE'S PARTICIPATION IN THE INTERSTATE MEDICAL LICENSURE COMPACT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to require (1) the streamlining
- 2 of the criminal history records check process required for participation
- 3 in the Interstate Medical Licensure Compact, and (2) the Commissioner
- 4 of Public Health to develop a grant proposal to secure funding to
- 5 modernize systems and reduce processing times to ensure compliance
- 6 with said compact.

Statement of Purpose:

To enable participation in and ensure compliance with the Interstate Medical Licensure Compact.
