## AN ACT AUTHORIZING RECIPROCAL LICENSURE FOR CERTAIN HEALTH CARE PROVIDERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 19a-131j of the general statutes be amended to allow,
- 2 absent a civil preparedness emergency or a public health emergency, for
- 3 reciprocal licensing, certification or registration of emergency medical
- 4 services personnel, occupational therapists, radiographers, radiologic
- 5 technologists, radiologist assistants, nuclear medicine technologists,
- 6 nurse's aides, dentists, dental hygienists, respiratory care practitioners,
- 7 behavior analysts, dietician-nutritionists, speech and language
- 8 pathologists and pharmacists who are appropriately licensed, certified
- 9 or registered in another state or territory of the United States or the
- 10 District of Columbia, to practice in Connecticut within the scope of the
- 11 profession for which the provider is licensed, certified or registered.

## Statement of Purpose:

To authorize reciprocal licensure for certain health care providers.
