AN ACT AUTHORIZING RECIPROCAL LICENSURE FOR CERTAIN HEALTH CARE PROVIDERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That section 19a-131j of the general statutes be amended to allow,
2 absent a civil preparedness emergency or a public health emergency, for
3 reciprocal licensing, certification or registration of emergency medical
4 services personnel, occupational therapists, radiographers, radiologic
5 technologists, radiologist assistants, nuclear medicine technologists,
6 nurse's aides, dentists, dental hygienists, respiratory care practitioners,
7 behavior analysts, dietician-nutritionists, speech and language
8 pathologists and pharmacists who are appropriately licensed, certified
9 or registered in another state or territory of the United States or the
10 District of Columbia, to practice in Connecticut within the scope of the
11 profession for which the provider is licensed, certified or registered.

Statement of Purpose:

To authorize reciprocal licensure for certain health care providers.
