AN ACT CONCERNING THE REGIONAL PLANNING INCENTIVE ACCOUNT DISTRIBUTION FORMULA.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

Section 1. Subsection (d) of section 4-66k of the general statutes is
 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective July 1*,
 2025):

(d) (1) For the fiscal years ending June 30, 2022, and June 30, 2023,
funds from the regional planning incentive account shall be distributed
to each regional council of governments [formed] <u>created</u> pursuant to
section 4-124j, in the amount of one hundred eighty-five thousand five
hundred dollars plus sixty-eight cents per capita, using population
information from the most recent federal decennial census.

10 (2) For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2024, and each fiscal year 11 thereafter, funds from the regional planning incentive account shall be 12 distributed to [the] each regional council of governments [formed] 13 created pursuant to section 4-124j, in [the] an amount totaling seven 14 million dollars. Such funds shall be distributed under a formula 15 determined by the Secretary of the Office of Policy and Management in 16 consultation with the regional [council] <u>councils</u> of governments, that 17 includes (A) a base payment amount payable to each such regional

18 council, and (B) a per capita payment amount to each such regional 19 council based upon population data for each such regional council from 20 the most recent federal decennial census, adjusted in accordance with 21 any change in the consumer price index for all urban consumers as 22 published by the United States Department of Labor, Bureau of Labor 23 Statistics, during the preceding twelve-month period, if such change 24 reflects an increase in said index. Such formula shall be reviewed and 25 updated [every five years after the initial adoption of such formula] 26 annually.

27 (3) Not later than July 1, 2021, and annually thereafter, each regional 28 council of governments shall submit to the secretary a proposal for 29 expenditure of the funds described in [subdivision (1) of] this 30 subsection. Such proposal may include, but need not be limited to, a 31 description of (A) functions, activities or services currently performed 32 by the state or municipalities that may be provided in a more efficient, 33 cost-effective, responsive or higher quality manner by such regional 34 council, a regional educational service center or similar regional entity; 35 (B) anticipated cost savings relating to the sharing of government 36 services, including, but not limited to, joint purchasing; (C) the 37 standardization and alignment of various regions of the state; or (D) any 38 other initiatives that may facilitate the delivery of services to the public 39 in a more efficient, cost-effective, responsive or higher quality manner.

To index the per capita payment amount to each regional council of governments from the regional planning incentive account to any increase in the consumer price index for all urban consumers.
