AN ACT CONCERNING ENERGY PURCHASING POOLS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. Section 16a-14e of the general statutes is repealed and the
- 2 following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective October 1, 2025*):
- The [Department] <u>Commissioner</u> of Energy and Environmental
- 4 Protection shall operate a purchasing pool for the purchase of electricity
- 5 for state operations. [Said department] <u>The commissioner</u> shall provide
- 6 [the opportunity to participate in such purchasing pool to] each
- 7 household that includes an individual who receives means-tested
- 8 assistance administered by the state or federal government with the
- 9 opportunity to participate in said purchasing pool. Any such household
- shall receive through such purchasing pool the same benefits and rate
- 11 discounts available for state facilities. The [Department of Energy and
- 12 Environmental Protection commissioner shall use federal and state
- 13 energy assistance funds to leverage the lowest practicable electric rates
- 14 for households participating in such pool, provided such funds shall not
- 15 be used for administrative purposes. The provisions of section 16-245
- 16 shall not apply to the [Department of Energy and Environmental

17 Protection] <u>commissioner</u> for purposes of this section.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following
sections:
