## AN ACT CONCERNING WORKFORCE SHORTAGES, WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT AND TRAINING.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (*Effective from passage*) The Commissioner of Economic and
- 2 Community Development shall conduct a study of workforce shortages,
- 3 workforce development and training availability. Such study shall
- 4 include, but need not be limited to, an analysis of the effect of such
- 5 shortages, development and availability on commercial activity in the
- 6 state. Not later than January 1, 2026, the commissioner shall submit a
- 7 report, in accordance with the provisions of section 11-4a of the general
- 8 statutes, on the results of such study to the joint standing committee of
- 9 the General Assembly having cognizance of matters relating to

10 commerce.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
