AN ACT CONCERNING LIVE DIGITAL VIDEO SCHOOL BUS VIOLATION DETECTION MONITORING SYSTEMS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. Subsection (e) of section 14-279a of the general statutes is
- 2 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (Effective from
- 3 passage):
- 4 (e) (1) A municipality or local or regional board of education that is
- 5 not operating a live digital video school bus violation detection
- 6 monitoring system pursuant to subsection (b) of this section prior to July
- 7 1, [2024] 2026, shall not (A) commence operation of such a system on or
- 8 after July 1, [2024] 2026, or (B) enter into an agreement with a private
- 9 vendor pursuant to subsection (b) of this section for the installation,
- operation and maintenance of such a system on or after July 1, [2024]
- 11 <u>2026</u>.
- 12 (2) A municipality or local or regional board of education, or a private
- vendor under an agreement pursuant to subsection (b) of this section,
- 14 that is operating a live digital video school bus violation detection
- 15 monitoring system pursuant to subsection (b) of this section on July 1,

- [2024] 2026, shall cease operation of such system not later than July 1,
 [2026] 2028, except as provided in subdivision (3) of this subsection.
- 18 (3) A private vendor operating a live digital video school bus 19 violation detection monitoring system may continue operating such 20 system on or after July 1, [2026] 2028, provided (A) the agreement 21 regarding such operation was entered into pursuant to subsection (b) of 22 this section prior to July 1, [2024] 2026, (B) no option to renew or extend 23 such agreement is exercised on or after July 1, [2024] 2026, that would 24 extend such operation to include any period of time on or after July 1, 25 [2026] 2028, and (C) such operation ceases upon termination of such 26 agreement.

To extend the sunset date applicable to the operation of live digital video school bus violation detection monitoring systems by municipalities and local or regional boards of education.
