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A BILL

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IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

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To symbolically designate, on an emergency basis, the public alley in Square 2655, bounded by Colorado Avenue, N.W., and Blagden Avenue, N.W., in Ward 4, as Zion Baptist Church Way.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this act may be cited as the “Zion Baptist Church Way Emergency Designation Act of 2014”.

Sec. 2. Pursuant to sections 401 and 403a of the Street and Alley Closing Acquisition Procedures Act of 1982, effective March 10, 1983 (D.C. Law 4-201; D.C. Official Code §§ 9-204.01 and 9-204.03a), the Council symbolically designates the public alley in Square 2655, bounded by Colorado Avenue, N.W., and Blagden Avenue, N.W., in Ward 4, as “Zion Baptist Church Way”.

Sec. 3. Transmittal.

The Chairman of the Council shall transmit a copy of this act, upon its effective date, to the Office of the Surveyor, the Office of the Recorder of Deeds, and District Department of Transportation.

Sec. 4. Fiscal impact statement.

The Council adopts the fiscal impact statement of the Chief Financial Officer as the fiscal impact statement required by section 602(c)(3) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 813; D.C. Official Code § 1-206.02(c)(3)).

33           Sec. 5. Effective date.

34           This act shall take effect following approval by the Mayor (or in the event of veto by the  
35 Mayor, action by the Council to override the veto), and shall remain in effect for no longer than  
36 90 days, as provided for emergency acts of the Council of the District of Columbia in section  
37 412(a) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 788;  
38 D.C. Official Code § 1-204.12(a)).
