18	Sec. 2. The Student Access to Treatment Act of 2007, effective February 2, 2008 (D.C.
19	Law 17-107; D.C. Official Code § 38-651.01 et seq.), is amended as follows:
20	(a) Section 2 (D.C. Official Code § 38-651.01) is amended as follows:
21	(1) The existing paragraph (1) is redesignated as paragraph (1A).
22	(2) A new paragraph (1) is added to read as follows:
23	"(1) "Designated epinephrine auto-injector" means a disposable drug delivery
24	system with a spring-activated needle, which is obtained with a prescription for a particular
25	person, that is designed for the emergency administration of epinephrine to a person suffering an
26	episode of anaphylaxis."
27	(b) Section 5a (D.C. Official Code § 38-651.04a) is amended as follows:
28	(1) Paragraph (b)(2) is amended by striking the word "undesignated."

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29	(2) A new subsection (e) is added to read as follows:
30	"(e) An employee or agent of a public school who is certified pursuant to this section may
31	administer a designated epinephrine auto-injector to the student to whom it is prescribed, who
32	the employee or agent believes in good faith to be suffering or about to suffer an anaphylactic
33	episode."

38	(a) This act shall take effect following approval by the Mayor (or in the event of veto by
39	the Mayor, action by the Council to override the veto), a 30-day period of Congressional review
40	as provided in section 602(c)(1) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December
41	24, 1973 (87 Stat. 813, D.C. Official Code § 1-206.02(c)(1)), and publication in the District of
42	Columbia Register.
43	(b) This act shall expire after 225 days of its having taken effect.
