A BILL

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

To amend, on a temporary basis, the Helicopter Landing Pad Public Nuisance Act of 1987 to allow hospital helipads as a matter of right.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this act may be cited as the “Aeromedical Transport Facilities Temporary Amendment Act of 2016”.

Sec. 2. Section 2 of the Helicopter Landing Pad Public Nuisance Act of 1987, effective October 9, 1987 (D.C. Law 7-40; D.C. Official Code § 9-1211.01), is amended as follows:

(a) A new subsection (c) is added to read as follows:

“(c) This section shall not apply to the operation of a helicopter landing pad at any hospital in the District of Columbia.”

Sec. 3. Fiscal impact statement.

The Council adopts the fiscal impact statement in the committee report as the fiscal impact statement required by section 4a of the General Legislative Procedures Act of 1975, approved October 16, 2006 (120 Stat. 2038; D.C. Official Code § 1-301.47a).

Sec. 4. Effective date.

24 This act shall take effect following approval by the Mayor (or in the event of veto by the
25 Mayor, action by the Council to override the veto), and shall remain in effect for no longer than
26 220 days, as provided for temporary acts of the Council of the District of Columbia in section
27 412(a) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 788;
28 D.C. Official Code § 1-204.12(a)).
