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22 IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

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25 To symbolically designate the street known as 1400 Cedar Street, S.E. as Davon T. McNeal, III  
26 Way.

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28 BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this  
29 act may be cited as the “Davon T. McNeal, III Way Designation Act of 2022”.

30 Sec. 2. Pursuant to sections 401, 403a, and 423 of the Street and Alley Closing and  
31 Acquisition Procedures Act of 1982, effective March 10, 1983 (D.C. Law 4-201; D.C. Official  
32 Code §§ 9-204.01, 9-204.03a, and 9-204.23), the Council symbolically designates the 1400 block  
33 of Cedar Street, S.E. as “Davon T. McNeal, III Way”.

34 Sec. 4. Fiscal impact statement.

35 The Council adopts the fiscal impact statement in the committee report as the fiscal  
36 impact statement required by section 4a of the General Legislative Procedures Act of 1975,  
37 approved October 16, 2006 (120 Stat. 2038; D.C. Official Code § 1-301.47a).

38           Sec. 5. Effective date.

39           This act shall take effect following approval by the Mayor (or in the event of veto by the  
40 Mayor, action by the Council to override the veto), a 30-day period of congressional review as  
41 provided in section 602(c)(1) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December  
42 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 813; D.C. Official Code § 1-206.02(c)(1)), and publication in the District of  
43 Columbia Register.
