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21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this
22 act may be cited as the “Wooten Court Designation Act of 2022”.

23 Sec. 2. Pursuant to sections 401, 403, and 421 of the Street and Alley Closing and
24 Acquisition Procedures Act of 1982, effective March 10, 1983 (D.C. Law 4-201; D.C. Official
25 Code §§ 9-204.01, 9-204.03, and 9-204.21), the Council officially designates the entire portion
26 of the public alley system within Square 3562, which is bounded by 3rd Street, N.E., W Street,
27 N.E., 4th Street, N.E., and V Street, N.E., as “Wooten Court”.

28 Sec. 3. Transmittal.

29 The Council shall transmit a copy of this act, upon its effective date, to the Mayor, the
30 District Department of Transportation, and the Office of the Surveyor.

31 Sec. 4. Fiscal impact statement.

32 The Council adopts the fiscal impact statement in the committee report as the fiscal
33 impact statement required by section 4a of the General Legislative Procedures Act of 1975,
34 approved October 16, 2006 (120 Stat. 2038; D.C. Official Code § 1-301.47a).

35 Sec. 5. Effective date.

36 This act shall take effect after approval by the Mayor (or in the event of veto by the
37 Mayor, action by the Council to override the veto), a 30-day period of congressional review as
38 provided in section 602(c)(1) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December
39 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 813; D.C. Official Code § 1-206.02(c)(1)), and publication in the District of
40 Columbia Register.
