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11 IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA
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16 To approve, on an emergency basis, the reprogramming request of Fiscal Year 2023 capital funds
17 in the amount of \$850,000 within the District Department of Transportation.
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19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this
20 act may be cited as the “District Department of Transportation Fiscal Year 2023 Reprogramming
21 Emergency Approval Act of 2023”.

22 Sec. 2. (a) Pursuant to section 47-363 of the District of Columbia Official Code, the Mayor
23 transmitted to the Council a reprogramming request in the amount of \$850,000 to be transferred
24 within the District Department of Transportation.

25 (b) The Council approves the \$850,000 reprogramming request.

26 Sec. 3. Fiscal impact statement.

27 The Council adopts the fiscal impact statement of the Budget Director as the fiscal impact
28 statement required by section 4a of the General Legislative Procedures Act of 1975, approved
29 October 16, 2006 (120 Stat. 2038; D.C. Official Code § 1-301.47a).

30 Sec. 4. Effective date.

31 This act shall take effect following approval by the Mayor (or in the event of veto by the
32 Mayor, action by the Council to override the veto), and shall remain in effect for no longer than
33 90 days, as provided for emergency acts of the Council of the District of Columbia in section
