

25 IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

30 To require that the District of Columbia Public Schools provide transportation to swing space
31 locations that are greater than a 1/2 mile from the school’s regular address.

32
33 BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this
34 act may be cited as the “Swing Space Transportation Support Act of 2023”.

35 Sec. 2. Swing Space Transportation Support.

36 (a) During a modernization or major capital renovation of a District of Columbia Public
37 Schools (“DCPS”) school facility, DCPS shall provide free round-trip transportation between the
38 school’s permanent campus and the school’s swing space campus in the following instances:

39 (1) If the school’s swing space is located outside the normal boundaries of the
40 school, or

41 (2) If the school’s swing space is located 1/2 mile or greater from the school’s
42 permanent address.

43 (b) For purposes of this section, the term “swing space” means a school’s temporary
44 location during a modernization or major capital renovation.

45 Sec. 3. Fiscal impact statement.

46 The Council adopts the fiscal impact statement in the committee report as the fiscal
47 impact statement required by section 4a of the General Legislative Procedures Act of 1975,
48 approved October 16, 2006 (120 Stat. 2038; D.C. Official Code§ 1-301.47a).

49 Sec. 4. Effective date.

50 This act shall take effect following approval by the Mayor (or in the event of veto by the
51 Mayor, action by the Council to override the veto), a 30-day period of congressional review as
52 provided in section 602(c)(1) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December
53 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 813; D.C. Official Code § 1-206.02(c)(1)), and publication in the District of
54 Columbia Register.
