33 act may be cited as the "Requirement to Provide Notice of Intent to Remove Public Litter
34 Containers Amendment Act of 2023".

35 Sec. 2. Section 13(c) of the Advisory Neighborhood Commissions Act of 1975, effective
36 March 26, 1976 (D.C. Law 1-58; D.C. Official Code § 1-309.10(c)) is amended by adding a new
37 paragraph (5) to read as follows:

38 "(5) The Department of Public Works ("DPW") shall give 30-days written notice,
39 excluding Saturdays, Sundays, and legal holidays, of the intent to remove a public litter container

40 from a public right of way, which shall include a brief description of why DPW believes
41 removing the litter container will improve neighborhood cleanliness and public health, to the
42 OANC, each affected Commission, and the Commissioner representing a single-member district
43 affected by said actions. The notice may be provided by electronic mail, subject to paragraph
44 (1A) of this subsection.”.
