10	To amend the Minimum Wage Act Revision Act of 1992 to clarify the District's minimum wage
11	and the circumstances under which an employer is required to pay the District's
12	minimum wage for all hours an employee works for the employer and to require
13	employers to pay the District's minimum wage for each hour an employee works in the
14	District when an employee performs at least 2 hours of work in the District in one
15	workweek for the same employer.
16	BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this
17	act may be cited as the "Minimum Wage Clarification Amendment Act of 2023".
18	Sec 2. Section 4 of the Minimum Wage Act Revision Act of 1992, effective March 25,
19	1993 (D.C. Law 9-248; D.C. Official Code § 32-1003), is amended as follows:
20	(a) Subsection (a) is amended as follows:
21	(1) Paragraphs (1), (2), (3), and (4) are repealed.
22	(2) Paragraph (5)(A) is amended by striking the phrase "wage required to be paid to
23	an employee by an employer shall" and inserting the phrase "wage shall" in its place.
24	(b) Subsection (b) is amended as follows:
25	(1) The lead-in language is amended to read as follows:
26	"(b) Except as provided in subsection (h) of this section, an employer shall pay the
27	minimum wage established pursuant to subsection (a) of this section to an employee for all hours
28	the employee works for the employer when:".

34	"(b-1) Except as provided in subsection (h) of this section, an employee shall not be paid
35	less than the District's minimum wage for each hour worked in the District when an employee
36	performs at least 2 hours of work in the District, for the same employer, within one workweek.".
